**Are you a leader with a Den Chief, or getting one soon, but not quite sure what they should be doing?**

Den Chief training is for Scouts who wish to become Den Chiefs for Cub and Webelos Dens, and for the leaders mentoring them. Den Chief is a leadership position within the Troop. This training works best when the Scout and the Cub/Webelos Den Leader go through the training together. The Cubmaster of the Pack should also attend, if possible, as well as any other interested Troop/Pack Leadership.
