

# INTRODUCTION TO Outdoor Leader Skills



- Who:** Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Crew Advisors, Associate Crew Advisors, and other adult volunteers who want to help with basic advancement skills and outdoor program activities, and who need to complete their training requirements.
- What:** Instruction designed to hone outdoor skills, conducted in a “mini Wood Badge” format using the patrol method. Focuses on Unit structure, event planning, camping, scouting skills, and outdoor cooking. Partially fulfills the training requirements for SM, ASM, VA, and AVA positions.
