"Camp Able" **Nautical Skills Training**

When: Sunday AM, June 23 through Saturday PM, June 29, 2019

Where: Solomon's, MD – 'U.S. Navy's Solomons Recreation Center'

Cost: \$375.00 per Sea Scout

Details: This event is open to all registered Sea Scouts from any Sea Scout Ship. **Space is limited to 20 Scouts total.** To reserve your spot, submit a non-refundable deposit of \$100 along with the registration form below. The remaining balance is due by June 1st. Anyone not submitting final payment in full by that time will lose their spot to someone on the waiting list. An e-mail confirmation will be sent once registration has been received.

A copy of the BSA Medical Form (Parts A, B, C) must be submitted with the final payment for each scout attending. Please be sure to keep the original for your own records. **No scout will be allowed to participate without this form on file at the beginning of Camp Able**

Those attending 'Camp Able' will be taught and gain practical application of all the nautical skill requirements for the Sea Scout ABLE Rank. There are still other Rank requirements to complete before becoming eligible for promotion to the Able Rank. While no one makes 'Able' Sea Scout by just attending a 1-week 'Camp Able' – you will be well on your way to knowing these advanced nautical skills. It's also an excellent tune-up for any Sea Scout SEAL Leadership Course

A packing list will be provided a month before camp. You must supply your own sleeping bag, mess kits, and all meals will be provided. All scouts will be expected to share in cooking meals and other camp chores. Every-other-day of 'Camp Able' is spent entirely out on-the-water sharpening these new skill sets in sailboats from 30-feet up to 36-feet.

As with all BSA functions, those attending are expected to maintain certain standards of behavior regarding safety, consideration for property and for others, and refraining from profanity or the use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs. No "flip-flop" shoes at any time. Anyone who does not abide by these standards will be sent home from camp at their parent's expense.
