**What: TREAD Lightly! Trainer Course**

Learn about the newest component of the Scouts BSA Outdoor Ethics program: TREAD Lightly! and how to share the concepts with Scouts and others. TREAD Lightly!'s train-the-trainer course is an intensive five-hour block of instruction designed to provide a foundation for outdoor ethics focusing on motorized and mechanized recreation on both land and water and on how to minimize impacts on roads, trails and the wild lands when accessed by recreationalist. Graduates of the course are certified able to present the TREAD Lightly! message to others in their state or region. Participants will work with Master TREAD Lightly! Trainers on understanding the role outdoor ethics play in the outdoor recreation community, learn the TREAD Lightly! principles of responsible recreational use, and will leave the course uniquely equipped with the tools to conduct workshops and coordinate community outreach. This training is of interest to all Scouters involved with the Scouts BSA outdoor ethics program, including rank advancement, youth leadership positions, awareness awards, and action awards.

All participants who register and pay-on line will receive a one year membership in the TREAD Lightly! Association, credits redeemable for instructor materials at the TREAD Lightly! Store, and access to electronic copies of training materials.
