National Capital Area Council Policy on Merit Badge Group Instruction

In an effort to give an appropriate amount of oversight to our districts to provide a quality merit badge program for our scouts, the following policy regarding merit badge group instruction is established by the council advancement and recognition committee.

- A troop or crew can use group instruction of merit badges within their unit without seeking approval from the council or district.
- If a unit decides to offer a merit badge opportunity to Scouts outside their unit, an individual
 counselor solicits scouts, or the district sponsors such an event, they must get district
 advancement committee approval to conduct the event. This affords the district
 advancement committee the opportunity to ensure compliance with the GTA guidance on
 group instruction.
- Council level groups such as Aquatics, Shooting Sports, the Jewish Committee, and STEM must get approval from either the Council Advancement Chair, Council Merit Badge Dean, or NCAC Advancement Committee Staff Advisor.
- Outside organizations to the BSA must always receive council approval from one of the aforementioned positions.
