

Scenario 1.

A youth currently active in a Scout troop.

- This fall during the "re-charter" process the adult leader will confirm that they are staying on the Roster for youth members.
- The BSA's online system will confirm the individual should pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 80 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 160 dollars.
- The unit will obtain from the Scout's family 160 dollars as they have obtained fees in the past.
 - Perhaps from what the Scout already has earned through Unit Fundraisers or dues paid to the Unit.
- The unit will submit the appropriate paperwork and fees, as they've done previously, as part of the Re-Charter process.

Scenario 2.

A youth joins Scouting for the first time between Aug. 1 and Dec. 31, 2023

- This fall during the Join Scouting Night campaign the family signs up to join a Cub Scout Pack via beAscout.org
- The BSA's online system will confirm the individual should pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 25 dollars to the BSA for New Member fees.
 - 0 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 105 dollars.
- The unit will confirm that the Family is active during Re-Charter this fall however, no fee will be generated.
- The family will renew their membership using the BSA's online system by September 13th, 2024 where they will pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 80 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 160 dollars.



Scenario 3.

A youth re-joins before Dec. 31, 2023 after more than a year hiatus.

- This fall during the Join Scouting Night campaign the family signs up to join a Cub Scout Pack via beAscout.org
- The BSA's online system will confirm the individual should pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 0 dollars to the BSA for New Member fees.
 - 0 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 80 dollars.
- The unit will confirm that the Family is active during Re-Charter this fall however, no fee will be generated.
- The family will renew their membership using the BSA's online system by September 13th, 2024 where they will pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 80 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 160 dollars.



Scenario 4.

A youth joins Scouting on or after Jan. 1, 2024.

- This fall during the Join Scouting Night campaign the family signs up to join a Cub Scout Pack, however the application never gets turned in until January.
- The BSA's system will confirm the individual should pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 25 dollars to the BSA for New Member fees.
 - 80 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 185 dollars.
- The family will renew their membership using the BSA's online system by January 14th, 2025 where they will pay:
 - 80 dollars to the BSA for membership fees.
 - 80 dollars to the NCAC for the participation fee.
 - Total due, without Scout Life magazine, of 160 dollars.
