Safe Swim Defense (SSD) and Safety Afloat (SA)



What: BSA Safe Swim Defense (26 min) and Safety Afloat (30 min) training is required for any BSA unit conduction swimming or boating activities. Who: Adult leaders supervising a swimming/boating activity must have completed Safe Swim Defense/Safety Afloat within the previous two years. Where: SSD and SA training is available online at https://my.scouting.org. Any in-person training must be presented by a qualified instructor. Cost: Free!

Paddle Craft Safety Training

<u>What</u>: This the hands-on training that is recommended in Safety Afloat guidelines for anyone conducting Scout boating activities. Two versions of the course are offered: The Basic course covers flat water introductory boating skills and basic trip planning. The river course includes skills and knowledge development that are required for conducting trips on moving water. The Basic course is a prerequisite for the moving water course. <u>Who</u>: Adult leaders

- Session 1*: May 18 (Still Water), May 19 (Moving Water)
- Session 2**: June 1 (Still Water), June 2 (Moving Water)
- Session 3**: Aug 24 (Still Water), Aug 25 (Moving Water)
- Session 4**: Sep 7 (Still Water), Sep 8 (Moving Water)

Where: * Still Water–Zoom/Silver Lake; Moving Water–Keedysville, MD ** Still Water–Camp Snyder; Moving Water-Riley's Lock

Cost: \$30/class day

Lifeguard Training

<u>What</u>: BSA Lifeguard Training is professional level training that meets the requirements of government agencies for professional lifeguards at regulated swimming activities. Lifeguard certification qualifies one for many summer opportunities. This class is being conducted by Campaign Pay It Forward (<u>https://campaignpayitforward.com/booking</u>, select BSA Lifeguarding from the pull-down menu) <u>Who</u>: The program is open to all registered adults and older youth (minimum age 15).
